### Florida Advocacy Guide – House of Representatives

On February 20, [the Florida House of Representatives voted 36-71 against a motion to consider a ban on many semiautomatic guns and large capacity magazines](#). This is unacceptable - the legislature must know that we will not rest until our state's gun laws are reformed.

Below are the names and emails of a few key legislators in the House. Thank the representatives who voted for the motion, and urge the representatives who voted against the motion to reconsider their position.
